## School Milk Cooler Grant Program

<b>What</b>	The Idaho Dairy Council (IDC) administrates the School Milk Cooler Grant Program with funds from the United Dairymen of Idaho.
<b>Why</b>	Many kids who don't drink school milk might choose milk if it were served cold, and if a variety of types and flavors were offered, and if it always tasted fresh.
<b>Who</b>	Anyone who participates in the National School Lunch Program is eligible to apply.
<b>Requirements</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Schools must be willing to complete a post evaluation sheet.</li><li>2. Schools must be willing to care properly for the cooler, including cleaning the condenser monthly.</li><li>3. Schools are responsible for service calls made on the milk coolers that are out of the one-year parts and labor warranty.</li></ol>
<b>Guidelines</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. It is encouraged that schools serve at least two flavors of milk in addition to white milk.</li><li>2. Schools should have a need for a milk cooler.</li><li>3. Schools should handle milk properly, to ensure that it will be fresh upon arriving in the cooler, and when served to the students.</li></ol>
